Students should verify that their schedule does not include any courses they are currently enrolled in or have previously earned high school credit.</p> <p>If students wish to make a request to change their intended schedule, they need to complete a Schedule Change Request Form. This form is located on the PAWS/Advisory website and Google Classroom.
