

## 2019 SENIOR CLASS ACTIVITIES

**Final Exams:** final exams are mandatory for all seniors unless they have exempted. They will be administered on Thursday, May 16<sup>th</sup> (1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> block) and Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup> (2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> block).

**Academic Honors Night:** Honors Night will be held on Tuesday, April 30<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm in the CCHS Auditorium.

**Senior Scholarship Night:** Senior Scholarship Night will be held on **Tuesday, May 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:00 P.M.** in the CCHS auditorium. **Seniors attending the program are asked to report to the (10-12) gym by 5:30 P.M.** While it is not required that all seniors attend this program, we encourage all of you to attend. Your families are also encouraged to attend!

**Dress Code (Scholarship Night & Graduation Ceremony):** Seniors must wear their cap and gown!

**Females:** Under your gown, you must wear a dark-colored dress or dark-colored skirt, no longer than the length of your graduation gown, dress pant suits are acceptable (navy blue or black). Dress shoes are required, flats are acceptable- they must be navy blue, black, or brown (no tennis shoes or flip-flops)! If hose\tights are worn, they must be neutral.

**Males:** Under your gown, you must wear dark-colored dress slacks, dark socks and dress shoes- navy blue, black or brown (no tennis shoes or flip-flops)! **Khaki colored slacks are not acceptable.** You must also wear a white or pastel-colored shirt, with a traditional tie (NO bow ties).

**Failure to adhere to dress code above will make you ineligible to participate in the Senior Scholarship Night or the Graduation Ceremony.**

**Graduation:** The Graduation Ceremony will be held at the Chris Gilman Stadium, **Friday, May 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 P.M.** **Seniors must report to the south end zone of the stadium for line-up at 6:00 P.M.**

**SENIORS ARE NOT TO PUT CAP AND GOWNS ON UNTIL THEY ARRIVE AT THE STADIUM.**

Handicapped and wheel chair seating space is available on the field with administrative approval.

**Rain-Out Procedure:** If the weather absolutely prohibits the ceremony from being held on May 24<sup>th</sup>, it will be rescheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 25<sup>th</sup>.

**Graduation starts promptly at 7:00 p.m.**

**Seniors must report to the south end of the end zone of the stadium for graduation line-up by 6:00p.m. Seniors are not to put their cap and gowns on until they arrive at the stadium.**

**Don't be late! No excuses! If you are late, you will not be allowed to participate.**

**You MUST attend practice to participate in graduation. Wanting to work instead is NO EXCUSE!**
