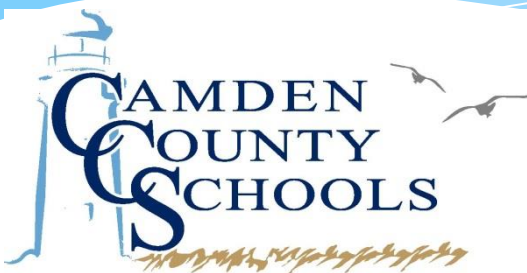


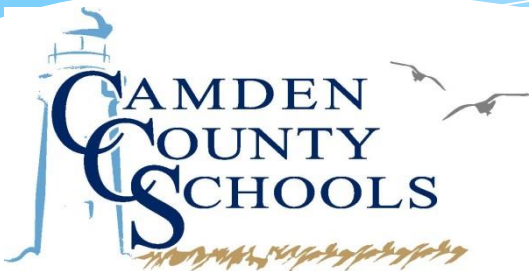

# What is Title I & How Can I be involved?

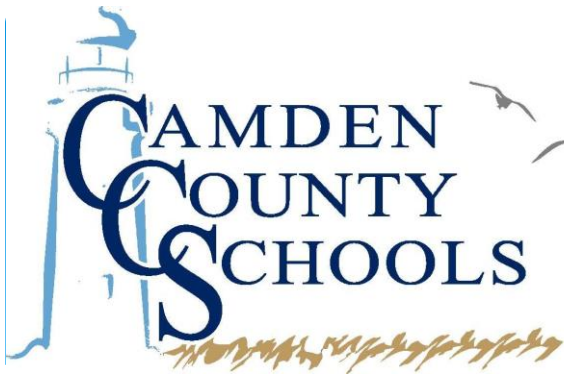
Title I Schools





## Definition of Title I:

- \* Title I provides federal funding to schools to help students who are low achieving or at most risk of falling behind.
- \* Title I is allocated to schools based on the percentage of student receiving free/reduced lunch.
- \* Schools with a percentage of at least 40% are eligible for a school-wide program.



# Welcome & Overview

- ❖ How does our school spend Title I money?

  - Upgrade of instructional program for the whole school

- ❖ How are Title I Parent and Family Engagement money spent?

  - 1% of Title I funds are spent on parent engagement
  - Parent Engagement materials – (brochures, paper, ink, booklets, pamphlets)



# CCHS School-wide Program

## School-wide means:

- The school uses Title I funds to upgrade the entire educational program of the school.
- Title I funds are used to serve all children in order to raise academic achievement.
- Title I funds will be used to provide additional assistance to all students who experience difficulties in meeting the State's performance targets.

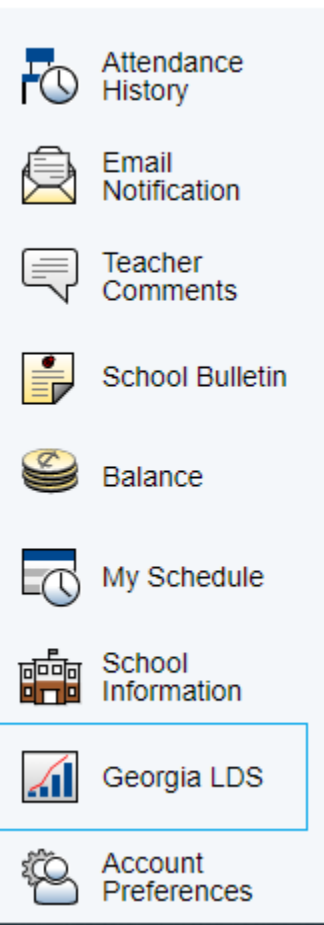

# Does my child's teacher meet professional qualifications?

- \*What is a parent's right to know
- \*In compliance with the requirements of the Every Student Succeeds Act, parents may request the following information:
  - \*Whether the student's teacher has met state qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
  - \*is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state qualification or licensing criteria have been waived
  - \*is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.
  - \*Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
