Please ask two adults that know you well to write a letter of reference. Ask one person that mentored your activities/projects showing your interest in the environment. Ask one teacher, who helped expand your knowledge and spark your interest in natural systems. The two adults should seal their letter of recommendation in an envelope with their initials on the flap. Please give your references some information about yourself in writing and give them at least two to three weeks to write the letter (ask them by February). Pick up the letters and include them in your scholarship packet.
