ELIGIBILITY

An applicant for the 2024 Brunswick (GA) Chapter of the Links Incorporated Scholarship Award must be an African American **high school senior** male or female from Camden, Glynn, or McIntosh County applying for summer or fall 2024 admission into an accredited four-year college/university. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required. One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior at Camden County High School, Glynn Academy, Brunswick High School, and McIntosh County Academy.
