The BullDawg Club is a local group of all things UGA...primarily football. Membership dues are paid annually and meals are enjoyed in the fall during football season where the games from the previous week are dissected and discussed. Victories are shared and defeats are sadly acknowledged for the best of Camden County's UGA fans to convene and socialize.

In 2014 members of the CCBC determined to create a competitive scholarship award for student(s) accepted and subsequently enrolled at the University of Georgia. It is the goal of many to attend The University of Georgia (UGA) and to be earning a degree from one of the South's most respected institutions. **UGA** is a land-grant and sea-grant university with statewide commitments and responsibilities. It is the state's oldest, most comprehensive and most diversified institution of higher education. Its motto, "to teach, to serve, and to inquire into the nature of things," reflects the University's integral and unique role in the conservation and enhancement of the state's and nation's intellectual, cultural, and environmental heritage.

This scholarship expects applicants to already be well schooled about UGA's rich history that has played important roles in the growth of our state and country. Applicants will submit necessary paperwork and up to five applicants will be selected to prepare to interview with appointed CCBC members. The interview will consist of questions related to UGA's academic, cultural, social and athletic history. The combination of school records and the interview will determine the receipt of one or more awards of at least \$500 to be used for school fees, living expenses and related expenditures. The scholarships are non-renewable and are based on knowledge of UGA's mission and the applicant's projected success at fulfilling that mission as a citizen.

Who is eligible to receive the annual award?

- Any Camden County high school senior accepted to the University of Georgia for the Fall following their graduation from high school
- Applicant must complete the application and be willing to be interviewed by CCBC members
- Award recipients are selected by the CCBC Scholarship Committee based on a scoring rubric valuing school records and interview responses.

What do applicants need to know?

- Applicants need to study information about the significant history, culture, academics, conservation, and athletics that are a part of UGA's story. Knowledge of Camden County's contributions or notable UGA graduates is helpful.

What happens at the interview?

- Applicants should consider the event similar to a job interview and prepare in dress and manner accordingly.
- Applicants will draw three of ten questions about the significant history, culture, academics, conservation, and athletics that are a part of UGA's story. Simply knowing UGA's athletic history will not be sufficient in responding to the questions. Applicants should be reasonably versed on how UGA is a flagship institution and what it truly means to be a proud UGA student and future graduate.
