## 2024 Camden-Kings Bay Navy League Council Scholarship

The Camden-Kings Bay Council of the Navy League of the United States is pleased to announce that once again they will be awarding **two \$2,000 Scholarships**. One will be the **2024 Gary Straight Scholarship**, and the second will be the **2024 Admiral William "Bull" Halsey Navy League Scholarship**. There will be two recipients, each will receive a \$2,000 scholarship. Each scholarship is open to a 2024 graduating senior from Camden County High School who **must be** a military dependent of an active duty or retired sea service member from one of the following branches: Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, or Merchant Marine.

Each scholarship will be awarded to a 2024 graduating senior attending an accredited college, community college or university during the 2024-2025 school year. Each award will be a one-time scholarship of \$1,000 per semester (total \$2,000) which will be paid directly to his/her selected institution for crediting to the recipient's account.

To be eligible to apply, students must meet the criteria as stated above/below and submit the following documents by the deadline:

- Personal Information Sheet: Full Name; Address; Phone Number; Parent(s) Name(s).
- 2. **Qualifying Status**: 2024 Camden County High School graduating senior of a sea service member (to include: branch of service, active duty or retired, name of current or last command), who has been accepted for enrollment in an accredited college, community college or university.
- 3. Copy of College Acceptance Letter
- 4. **Certified copy** of high school **transcript** to include students class standing.
- 5. **Two Letters of Recommendation** from teaching professionals currently employed at Camden County High School.
- 6. **Essay-**500-750-word original essay addressing the topic specified in the essay subject described below. A well-written essay will require research and original thought. Essays will be graded on grammar, content, originality, persuasiveness, and passion for the topic.
- 7. **Financial need** will also be a consideration in the selection process. Each applicant is required to submit a brief statement on how/why the scholarship would benefit them in furthering their education.
- 8. Once awarded the initial \$1,000 scholarship, each recipient must maintain acceptable academic progress. The recipients must attain qualifying enrollment status to receive the subsequent second semester \$1,000 funding. Each recipient will be **required** to submit a copy of their first

semester grades to indicate that they are in good standing to continue or proof of enrollment for the next term of study.
