

The Saltwater Performing Arts Bob Cannistraro Scholarship Fund 2024 Application

Bob Cannistraro had an appreciation for the role that performing arts plays in the lives of young people. He recognized that the best performances do not always happen in theaters. They take place in the classrooms, in the home, at work, and any place people gather to interact with others. When you build a child's creativity, there are no limits to what he or she can do.

Bob believed that creative arts (education or experience) is the right of all youth no matter the socio-economic challenges they may face. Through his family's generosity a scholarship fund was created in 2017 to enable our youth to further their performing arts education. This scholarship will ensure that Bob's legacy endures long into the future.

One aspect of The Saltwater Performing Arts Bob Cannistraro Scholarship Fund is to provide financial assistance to a graduating senior pursuing a post-secondary degree in the performing arts field (including degrees in performing arts performance, theory, education, composition, business).

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating senior within a 40-mile radius of 204 Arnow Dr. St Marys, GA.
- 2. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. (Max 5 Points)
- 3. Applicant must accurately complete the application package.
- 4. Applicant must include 3 letters of recommendation. (Max 5 Points for each letter)
- 5. Applicant must submit an essay **and** answer one challenge question. (Max 20 Points for each)
- 6. Applicant must include a copy of the acceptance letter from a college, university, junior college, and must agree to pursue a degree in the performing arts field.

DEADLINE AND HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. **Application must be received by midnight April 15, 2024**. Applications received after midnight April 15, 2024 will not be considered. If mailed, must be postmarked on or before April 13, 2024.
- 2. Application, all pages associated with the application, and reference letters, should be:

NUMBER OF AWARDS: Maximum of 3

AMOUNT OF AWARDS: Up to \$1,000 (based on number of awards granted)

METHOD OF DISBURSEMENT: Upon proof of enrollment, scholarship awards are paid and mailed directly to the college or university. If a scholarship recipient does not enroll in a selected college, university, junior college, the scholarship will be null and void.

SCHOLARSHIP DURATION: This scholarship is awarded for the period of one academic year.

- 1) What challenges do you foresee in the performing arts field based on your experiences and how can they be overcome? Maximum 500 words
- 2) With your degree, what contribution to your future community do you see yourself making, how will you achieve that and who will be impacted by it? Maximum 500 words

_____Three (3) letters of recommendation. Recommendations should come from a teacher, mentor, and a prominent leader in your local community. Recommendation letters should reflect detailed information as to why the student deserves this performing arts scholarship. We ask that these letters be emailed directly by the author to: Admin @SaltwaterPAC.org, Subject Line - *Letter of Recommendation - Student Name.* Recommendation Letters are due by midnight, March 15.
