Arnold Dewitt Joseph was born in Kingsland, Georgia but grew up in Port Arthur, Texas. Arnold Dewitt Joseph returned to Kingsland with his parents when he was a teenager and resided here until his death.

Arnold Dewitt Joseph joined Saint Paul African Methodist Episcopal Church, Kingsland Georgia where he served faithfully and dutifully for most of his adult life. Arnold Dewitt Joseph was Superintendent of the Church Sunday School, Trustee Board Officer, Steward Board Member, Financial Board Officer and the Church Accountant. Also, as the Church Accountant, he created and formatted a template for the church that allowed Saint Paul AME Church here in Kingsland to pay off their church mortgage in less than seven years (a 30 year mortgage). He did this with no financial or accounting education or experience; but a love for his church family and GOD.

Arnold Dewitt Joseph was a husband, father, brother and a man after God's own heart. His love for his family, church, community and the young children was seen through his constant, unrelenting efforts to inspire change in each of their lives.

Arnold Dewitt Joseph was a person of action. His belief was that our young people had the talent and aptitude to be a catalyst for positive change. His motto was "if you don't get it right the first time- do it again; and again; and again until it is great!" Arnold Dewitt Joseph was the children's greatest cheerleader.

Arnold initiated the collaboration that led to several annual "marches against drugs" with the mayor of Kingsland and statewide dignitaries, namely, Mayor Andrew Young of Atlanta. Hence, the entire Camden County benefited from this successful movement by Arnold Joseph.

He believed that in order for our young children to have a chance to grow and learn they needed to be safe and feel protected. Therefore, he was willing to help support our young children as they were nurtured and allowed to have that opportunity. It is because of the sacrifice, as well as the passion of this dedicated person that we, the Pastor, officers and members of Saint Paul African Methodist Episcopal Church salute **Arnold Dewitt Joseph** with this honor.
