- Must demonstrate a commitment to volunteerism.
- Must be a Camden County resident.
- Must be in good academic standing with their secondary school.
- Must be a high school senior receiving a diploma.
- Must submit a 4-year high school transcript (scanned/emailed is acceptable).
- Must submit a letter of recommendation from a current teacher, coach, or advisor.
- Applicants must enroll as a student at an accredited college/university in the 2024-2025 school year (fall or spring semester).
  - Please include a copy of your acceptance letter from the college/university you will be attending.
- Application must be typed, double spaced, with font size 12. Maximum 500 word count per essay.
- Must submit a completed scholarship application form to be scanned and e-mailed to the address listed below.


## **Application Process:**
