

Hospital/Homebound Program

Students who have medical problems that prohibit them from attending school for an extended period may be eligible for the services of the hospital/homebound program. Under this program, the school will provide a teacher to secure assignments/materials from the student's classroom teachers and to visit the student in his/her home to provide individual instruction while the student is incapacitated. While a student is being served under this program, he/she will be counted present in all of his/her classes.

The basic requirements for eligibility in the program include:

1. Student must have a certified doctor's statement on the prescribed application, indicating said student will be unable to attend school for at least ten (10) school days.
2. Student's illness must not be communicable.
3. The Hospital/Homebound does not serve emotional illness.
