2024 GRADUATION NIGHT

Graduation starts promptly at 7:00 P.M on Friday, May 24th.

Please plan to leave home early due to traffic.

Seniors must report to the south end of the end zone of the stadium for **graduation line-up by 6:00 P.M.** Seniors are not to put their cap and gowns on until they arrive at the stadium.

Don't be late! No excuses! If you are late, you will not be allowed to participate.

<u>Dress Code</u> (Scholarship Night, Baccalaureate & Graduation Ceremony): Seniors must wear their cap and gown.

<u>Females</u>- Under your gown, you must wear a dark-colored dress or dark-colored skirt, no longer than the length of your graduation gown, dress pant suits are acceptable (navy blue or black). Dress shoes are required, flats are acceptable and encouraged. Dress shoes must be navy blue, black or brown (no tennis shoes or flip flops)! If hose/tights are worn, they must be neutral.

<u>Males-</u> Under your gown, you must wear dark-colored dress slacks, darks socks and dress shoes-navy blue, black or brown (no tennis shoes or flip flops)! <u>Khaki colored slacks are not acceptable</u>. You must wear a white or pastel-colored shirt, with a traditional tie (NO bow ties).

Failure to adhere to dress code above will make you ineligible to participate in Senior Scholarship Night and/or the Graduation Ceremony.

Graduation Ceremony will be held at the Chris Gilman Stadium on Friday, May 24th at 7:00 P.M. Seniors must report to the south end zone of the stadium for line-up at 6:00 P.M.

Handicapped and wheelchair seating space is available on the field with administrative approval.

SENIORS ARE NOT TO PUT CAP AND GOWNS ON UNTIL THEY ARRIVE AT THE STADIUM!

<u>Rain-Out Procedure</u>: If the weather absolutely prohibits the ceremony from being held on May 24th, it will be rescheduled for 10 A.M. on Saturday, May 25th.

Diploma Pick Up

Immediately following <u>graduation</u> on May 24th, students may sign for and pick up their diploma on the North end zone of the football field.

If you are unable to pick up your diploma immediately after graduation, you may pick up in the guidance office during school hours. You must have your ID in order to pick up.

Final Transcript Request

Students are asked to complete a form in advisement indicating where they would like their final transcript to be sent. You do not need to make another request; this will serve as your request to have a final transcript to be sent to your college/university of choice.
